## **WHAT'S INSIDE Grounds for Involuntary Rights**

Section 1033: Condemnation and Involuntary Conversions. Originally placed in the Tax Code in 1921, Internal Revenue Code Section 1033 governs the tax consequences when a property is compulsorily or involuntarily converted in whole or in part into cash or other property. 1 This is commonly referred to as an involuntary conversion since the loss of property is beyond the control of the taxpayer.

## **Section 1033: Condemnation and Involuntary Conversions**

Voluntary non attendance at work, without valid reason. Absenteeism means either habitual evasion of work, or willful absence as in a strike action.It does not include involuntary or occasional absence due to valid causes, or reasons beyond one's control, such as accidents or sickness.See also attendance management.
