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Have a student volunteer read the story on the Metaphors and Similes worksheet. Have students identify the similes and metaphors in the story by underlining them and writing them on the spaces provided on the worksheet. Guide students as they identify the examples of each by reminding them that similes use "like or "as" and metaphors do not.
